Build the Protests Against Cuts & NAMA

Enough is enough. If Bord Snip’s cutback proposals are implemented, they will inflict terrible suffering on working class communities, the elderly, the young and the most vulnerable in our society.

Bord Snip plans to take €1.8 billion from social welfare, €1.2 billion from healthcare, €746 million from education. These cuts would plunge the already poorest in our society into a situation where they will simply be unable to cope. Our already, desperately under-resourced health service and education system will be devastated.

It is utterly unacceptable that this government want working people and the least well-off pay for a crisis created by the greed of bankers, developers, the super-wealthy and the politicians that facilitated them.

Disgracefully, these savage cutbacks are to be imposed while the government plans to push through the NAMA scheme and pump €57 billion into bailing out the bankers and developers, whose greed caused the crisis in the first place.

Only people power can now force the government to abandon these cuts and the insane NAMA plan. We need to build an alliance of workers, communities, students, pensioners, unemployed and local communities to demand that those that created this crisis pay to clean it up.

We must sustain and escalate the protests until the government backs off or we force them out of office altogether.

We must say:

- **No cuts in health, education, social welfare or in vital community and public services.**
- **No to NAMA – Bail out jobs and services not the bankers and developers.**
- **Invest public resources in jobs, services and public enterprise.**
- **Tax the super-wealthy elite and slash the salaries of politicians, corporate bosses and top civil servants.**
- **Defend, jobs pay and conditions and pensions for all low and average earning workings in both the private and public sector.**

The recently formed United Alliance Against Cuts (UAAC) plans to hold a protest every Wednesday evening at 6.30pm outside the Dail, starting on Wednesday Oct 7th and continuing until we force the government to abandon its NAMA plans which are due to be voted upon in the Dail by the middle of October.

UAAC have also called a Protest outside the special Green Party conference on Saturday October 10th (time and venue have yet to be announced) where the Green party will meet to decide if they are going to support the NAMA scheme and continue to support the Fianna Fail government. We need to put massive pressure on the Green Party to end its support for this failed and bankrupt government.

We appeal to all those angry about the cut backs to join these protests and get involved in the United Alliance Against Cuts.
